After 3-4 contractor's combination will be changed. Has been in contact with Dan Stahl, representative for loans at Independent Bank. To refinance two loans and add 125,000 our payments would be \$2,810/month. Interest would be 5-year balloon, fixed rate 4.25%. Current loans are on higher payments. We can pay off early if we want to with no penalty.

**h. Frank Guerin:** Buildings and Grounds: Tom noticed multiple shingles missing off the office roof, we needed to replace/repair shingles and found a few soft spots. Roof is estimated to be installed in the early 2000s, so it is approximately 19 years old. Working on getting pricing for new roof materials, we may be able to repair the roof ourselves. Talked with Coach equipment for evaluations and have a few options. Option 1: We write down every piece of equipment and send it to them possibly for a couple hundred dollars. Option 2: they come out and spend a few hours and evaluate the equipment, the cost would be more due to more time involved. Checked propane pricing with Tri-Gas. \$1.459/gallon for pre-buy is less would have to use at least 500 gallons. Price cap 1.559/gallon or could be on the

market rate. Recommends pre-buy option to save. Prices would remain capped until March 31, 2021. Grants: Day 1 of grant classes is complete, 5 more weeks to go. Concessions: We will be enforcing the trailer usage for food vendors.
